ACADEMIC LOAD POLICY (COLLEGE)

This policy is the responsibility of the Registrar and was approved by Faculty Senate. This policy was revised on January 27, 2012.

POLICY OVERVIEW

This policy outlines the process involved for academic load.

PRINCIPLES

The principles of natural justice, clarity and transparency undergird this policy.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all undergraduate students.

POLICY STATEMENT

The normal academic load for full-time students is 12-18 credit hours per semester (the number of credits in a full course load can vary from program to program and from year to year within a program). Students who are on academic probation or who are continuing under a Student Success Contract may have their course load restricted. Permission can be requested from the Registrar's Office to enrol in more than 18 credit hours. To be eligible for consideration, students must have successfully completed 30 credit hours and have a cumulative GPA of 2.7.
